Why is digging deep into truth in "The American Gospel: Christ Crucified" important? BECAUSE...

- ➤ We live in the context of spiritual war
- ★ satan uses people to deceive and lead people away from God and His truth

Ephesians 4:17–5:2

2 Timothy 4:3–5 (ESV) ³For the time is coming when people will not endure sound teaching, but having itching ears they will accumulate for themselves teachers to suit their own passions, ⁴and will turn away from listening to the truth and wander off into myths. ⁵As for you, always be sober-minded, endure suffering, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry.

2 Corinthians 11:13–15 (ESV) ¹³For such men are false apostles, deceitful workmen, disguising themselves as apostles of Christ. ¹⁴And no wonder, for even Satan disguises himself as an angel of light. ¹⁵So it is no surprise if his servants, also, disguise themselves as servants of righteousness. Their end will correspond to their deeds.

Why are Chapter 3 topics important?

- ✓ hell or no hell
- \checkmark the exclusivity of Christ as Lord, Messiah, the One and only Who forgives and saves

BECAUSE...

- 1. It's the Biblical truth it is important that we believe God's truth because it IS the truth regardless of implications
- 2. Those who don't trust in the only true God are lost for eternity
- 3. satan's strategy is to discredit the Bible and dishonor God, thus we need to **be firm** in our belief in the Bible as God's Word, *understand* God through His Bible and *cling* to both.

<u>Theism</u> – God as creator of universe out of nothing and distinct from His creation – omnipresent b/c cannot be contained in any one location of His creation whereas

<u>**Pantheism**</u> – opposite of that, God = Universe – God and creation are one and the same, the leaves are God, rocks are God, identical

<u>**Panentheism**</u> ("All in God") – God is in creation, and creation is in God but God also transcends creation
