INTRODUCTION

“Experiencing God” is not a phrase one hears in most religious circles. And yet... that is **EXACTLY** what Christianity is all about. Jesus didn’t sacrifice everything to come to earth, live among us, and die for people to have nice religion and rituals. He came so that we can **experience** what God originally designed – an intimate relationship of walking and working together to accomplish His purposes, conquering the forces of darkness.

This journal is designed to help you do just that. The times in which we live require nothing less. Hear Jesus’ words:

²³But the hour is coming, and is now here, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for the Father is seeking such people to worship him. ²⁴God is spirit, and those who worship him must worship in spirit and truth.” John 4:23–24 (ESV)

Jesus uses 3 words to describe the life of **experiencing** God.

Worship – a WAY OF LIFE that reveals the “worth-ship” of Jesus as the Son of God. Worship is not a Sunday service or singing hymns. It is living in intimacy and obedience.

Spirit – a WAY OF LIFE with the Holy Spirit living within us so that we walk in step with God. That results in the Holy Spirit within us resonating with God moment by moment.

Truth – a WAY OF LIFE of living by what is TRUE; living in reality rather than falsehood with Jesus as THE Truth and the definer of all that is real.

Fewer verses, deeper diving in 2021.

There are fewer verses in the daily scripture readings this year so that you can read them TWICE to let God’s truth soak in more deeply.

Daily questions to do the deep dive.

At the top of each week’s reading are three questions to use daily to lead you to hear God’s voice, make sense of it and then act on it. It’s not about simply knowing more about God; it’s about **experiencing God!**

Journal Features

Word for the Year. A practice many people have found helpful is to receive a word from God as His theme. Ask God to give you His single word for 2021. See the next page for details.

Sample Appointment with God. On the following page is an outline for your daily time with God using scripture reading, prayer and a devotional book. Start with that template and adjust as works best for you. God will steer your appointment to make it a meaningful, wonderful, challenging and life-giving time with Him as your loving, almighty, Heavenly Dad.

Weekday Scripture Readings. We start 2021 reading the Gospel of John to more deeply discover WHO Jesus is and the TRUTH about Him. In this Gospel we discover that Jesus identifies Himself with a multitude of images, parables, teachings and commands. One of those is in John 14:6 and is very important for us in the times in which we live.

Jesus said to him, “I am **the** way, and **the** truth, and **the** life. No one comes to the Father except through me.” **John 14:6 (ESV)**

Weekend Scripture Readings. No, that’s not a typo. One way we will deep dive into scripture is by reading the same verses from Proverbs on both weekend days, listening for God’s voice.

Daily Questions. As mentioned in the introduction, use the three questions at the top of each week’s list of readings to dive deeper into the verses. Be sure to write SOMETHING, even if just a few words each day.

ADDITIONAL RESOURCES. The following are helpful study aids and are available to purchase or to use free online.

Study Bibles. Pastor Herb recommends the ESV Study Bible. A study Bible provides an introduction to each of the books of the Bible, notes at the bottom of each page that provide basic explanation of the text, timelines, maps and more.

Bible commentaries and dictionaries. These go from simple to complex, providing more background than a study Bible. You can choose one appropriate to the depth of study you desire in book form or online. <https://biblehub.com/commentaries/> is the online resource Pastor Herb uses most.

2021 Word for the Year

One practice to consistently ***Experience God*** throughout the year is to ask God to give you His word for you - a word He will use persistently throughout the year. Instead of a resolution that falls flat by February, let God give you a word. God's one word for you will serve as a reminder of His Presence and His work in your life as it inspires, encourages and challenges. Here are some simple steps to receive God's word for you for 2021.

1. Pray. Take time each day to ask God for His word for you.
2. Jot down any words that come to you – all the words that come to mind. Don't self-edit at this point.
3. Ask God to show you the one word He wants for you. As you surrender to listen, God WILL speak by bringing the word to you in a way that resonates in your soul.
4. Keep the word in front of you. It will serve as a reminder of what God wants to teach you and how He wants to transform and use you throughout the year. As trials arise, it will help you to stay focused through the battle.

A Sample Appointment with God

Below is a template for experiencing God as you daily meet with Him. Remember, it is about relationship not ritual, so focus on interacting with God.

Begin with **at least 15 minutes** and work up to 30 minutes. Find a regular place and time each day, then spend time with God.

Surrender... Listen... Obey

1. Quiet Yourself – pause a moment to settle your spirit.
2. Say to God something like, “Good morning, Lord. Thank You for inviting me to be with You. I surrender myself and I’m listening. Please speak to me and transform me.”
3. Read the daily devotional book, “Experiencing God Day by Day.” Look, **listen** and write down insights God.
4. Read the daily Bible passage TWICE.
 - A. Read it the first time to find the overall thought.
 - B. Ask God to specifically speak to you through the scripture.
 - C. Read it a second time slowly, taking in the words as if drinking deeply. Actively look, **listen** and record what you sense God says to you by using these questions.
 1. What stood out or caught your attention?
 2. Why do you think it caught your attention?
 3. What does God want you to do with it and how?
5. Talk with God (remember prayer is conversation).
 - A. Express praise and thanks
 - B. Ask if there’s anything you need to surrender or confess – listen and do so
 - C. Pray for others.
 1. Salvation for those lost from God
 2. Needs you know of or God brings to mind
 3. Yourself
 - D. Surrender your day to God and ask Him to lead You.

Throughout the day, talk with Him and listen for Him. Your appointment is sitting with your Loving Heavenly Dad and Almighty God in full concentration; the rest of your day is walking with Him as you stay in touch.
