2023 Word for the Year

One practice to consistently **Experience God** throughout the year is to ask God to give you His word for you - a word He will use persistently throughout the year. Instead of a resolution that falls flat by February, let God give you a word. God's one word for you will serve as a reminder of His Presence and His work in your life as it inspires, encourages and challenges. Here are some simple steps to receive God's word for you for 2022.

1. Pray. Take time each day to ask God for His word for you.
2. Jot down any words that come to you – all the words that come to mind. Don't self-edit at this point.
3. Ask God to show you the one word He wants for you. As you surrender to listen, God WILL speak by bringing the word to you in a way that resonates in your soul.
4. Keep the word in front of you. It will serve as a reminder of what God wants to teach you and how He wants to transform and use you throughout the year. As trials arise, it will help you to stay focused through the battle.

A Sample Appointment with God

Below is a template for experiencing God as you daily meet with Him. Remember, it is about relationship not ritual, so focus on interacting with God.

Begin with **at least 15 minutes** and work up to 30 minutes. Find a regular place and time each day, then spend time with God.

Surrender... Listen... Obey

1. Quiet Yourself – pause a moment to settle your spirit.
2. Say to God something like, “Good morning, Lord. Thank You for inviting me to be with You. I surrender myself and I’m listening. Please speak to me and transform me.”
3. Read the daily devotional book, “Experiencing God Day by Day.” Look, **listen** and write down insights God.
4. Read the daily Bible passage TWICE.
 - A. Read it the first time to find the overall thought.
 - B. Ask God to specifically speak to you through the scripture.
 - C. Read it a second time slowly, taking in the words as if drinking deeply. Actively look, **listen** and record what you sense God says to you by using these questions.
 1. What stood out or caught your attention?
 2. Why do you think it caught your attention?
 3. What does God want you to do with it and how?
5. Talk with God (remember prayer is conversation).
 - A. Express praise and thanks
 - B. Ask if there’s anything you need to surrender or confess – listen and do so
 - C. Pray for others.
 1. Salvation for those lost from God
 2. Needs you know of or God brings to mind
 3. Yourself
 - D. Surrender your day to God and ask Him to lead You. Throughout the day, talk with Him and listen for Him. Your appointment is sitting with your Loving Heavenly Dad and Almighty God in full concentration; the rest of your day is walking with Him as you stay in touch.

INTRODUCTION TO JANUARY DAILY SCRIPTURES

The daily scriptures for January are designed to focus us on Christ, His work and then begin to look at God's beginnings in Genesis.

Colossians is a New Testament book that highlights the superiority of Christ. The number of verses is intentionally short so you can truly focus and listen for what God will show you.

Revelation 21-22 are the final two chapters of the Bible, describing God's restoration of His original plan. These give us the picture of the end before we go to the beginning in Genesis.

Genesis is God's record of the beginning.

WEEKENDS

Psalms is a book of songs in conversation with or about God. Read the assigned Psalm on both Saturday and Sunday to focus on God.

DAILY TIME WITH GOD

1. Start on your knees

This is about surrender and praise. By positionally surrendering yourself at the start of your day you put God in the God spot and yourself in the child of God spot. You can stay on your knees a long or short time, but start your day and your appointment with Him there with a prayer something like this:

"Lord, I bow before you in surrender and praise. I give my life to You as All Powerful, All Knowing, All Present, All Loving God. Guide me through this day to know You, honor You, serve You and represent You. In Jesus' Name, Amen."

2. Read the devotional for the day from "Hearing God Through the Year" by Dallas Willard. The purpose of a daily devotional is to pull your focus to God and His purposes. We encourage New Singers to read the same one as a way to unify us.

3. Read the assigned daily Bible passage.

Read it once, then read the application questions at the top of the page.

Read it a second time slowly looking for the answers to those questions.

Record the answers to the questions and any other thoughts that seem important in the pages provided or a journal of your choice.

4. Talk with God.

Using the 3 questions for Bible reading is actually praying – interacting with God about what He is saying to you through the Bible.

PRAISE. Recognize God as God and thank Him for what He is doing.

LISTEN. Pause to ask God if He wants to say anything to you. When thoughts come to mind, write them down.

REQUESTS. Pray for others first and then yourself. **WRITE** down requests and answers

COMMIT and **SURRENDER.** End your time with God by committing to do anything God said and nudges throughout your day.
