### **Review:**

- About a relationship, not rules, not activity
- About understanding that Jesus is the ONLY WAY for us to be in right standing with God
- **The RESULT** of true spirituality is rest, refreshment, and joy!
- Surrender is TAUGHT and MODELED by Jesus, Himself
- Surrender is **the CHANNEL** through which God's biggest and best blessings flow.
- We are in a **REAL BATTLE** against satan and a world system designed to destroy us
- God's Word is the **KEY** to winning the battle and transform our hearts and minds
- God is the ONLY ONE to give us an accurate view of ourselves
- I must get into God's Word and understand who I am in Christ

3 questions:

Authentic community happens when the real you meets real needs for the right reasons in the right way.

Romans 12:9-13 Marks of the True Christian

Let love be genuine. Abhor what is evil; hold fast to what is good. Love one another with brotherly affection. Outdo one another in showing <u>honor</u>. Do not be <u>slothful in zeal</u>, be fervent in spirit, <u>serve the Lord</u>. Rejoice in <u>hope</u>, be patient in <u>tribulation</u>, be constant in <u>prayer</u>. Contribute to the needs of the saints and seek to show hospitality.

John 13:34-35 (ESV) <sup>34</sup> A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another. <sup>35</sup> By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."

**John 13:3-5** (**ESV**) <sup>3</sup> Jesus, knowing that the Father had given all things into his hands, and that he had come from God and was going back to God, <sup>4</sup> rose from supper. He laid aside his outer garments, and taking a towel, tied it around his waist. <sup>5</sup> Then he poured water into a basin and began to wash the disciples' feet and to wipe them with the towel that was wrapped around him.

John13:17 (ESV) If you know these things, blessed are you if you do them.

### Romans 12: 12, 13

True community is not defined by a warm, fuzzy feeling. rather, it is defined be <u>self-sacrificing</u> love.
