Ephesians 4:12-16 (ESV)

Biblical Pattern of transformation and Ephesians 3:20 promises

† Surrender in "just enough trust"...

usually because of pain ...

sometimes for a little while, often for a long while...

typically looks bleak and/ or impossible

1 Peter 5:6 Humble yourselves, therefore, under the mighty hand of God so that at the proper time he may exalt you

† God moments – when God changes something

not because we deserve it or have earned it, but because we made ourselves available to Him by surrendering
MANY miss them because they give up too soon

† Deeper intimacy and alignment - satisfies soul deep and results in fruit of the Spirit

107:9 (ESV) For he satisfies the longing soul, and the hungry soul he fills with good things.

† Assignment – partnership with Christ for Kingdom purposes

Matthew 20:28 even as the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many."

† Repeat – Surrender, God moment, intimacy & alignment, assignment

ever deepening, often increasing ER cost along with surrender for eternal HR purposes

✓ **What thoughts, questions, observations do you have 5 months into Bible Recap?**

Herb: noticing that some non-history books are "moments" that provide examples of relationship and partnership with God such as Deuteronomy, Job, Ruth, Esther. Others are resources for relationship and partnership with God such as Psalms, Proverbs, Song of Solomon

Note again David's habit of neglecting to consult God
